

SPEEDWATCH REPORT (MARCH 2019)

Report to Parish Council 18th April 2019

Since the last meeting we have a new volunteer who has now completed three sessions, there are 7 volunteers listed on the system, although some are currently not able to give a great deal of time. With holiday time approaching we anticipate that sessions over the next few weeks will be a little light at times.

During March we ran 20 sessions totalling 15 hours, with one further session cancelled when an operator became unavailable. Those sessions recorded a total of 67 vehicles from 3,755 vehicles that passed during the sessions, that is approx. 1.8% of vehicles recorded, the fastest speed recorded was 48mph.

Three half hour sessions did not record any speeding vehicles from the 680 that passed during the three sessions. During the month two of the recorded vehicles were shown to have no tax and/or MOT.

So far this month we have completed 14 sessions with another 7 planned.
