SPEEDWATCH REPORT

Parish Council 16th May 2019

During April we ran 20 sessions totalling approx. 14.5 hours, two further sessions were cancelled due to operators becoming unavailable.

The sessions recorded 128 vehicles from 3585 that passed during the sessions (4%), the fastest speed recorded was 54 mph, the average accuracy of the sessions was 89.7%.

One vehicle was shown not to have tax and/or MOT.

Two of the vehicles failed the DVLA check due to colour error, they were both vans so had probably been resprayed in company colours and DVLA not notified, a third was a school minibus listed as white but is green, so again resprayed and not notified.

So far this month we have carried out 12 sessions with 12 more planned, three sessions have been cancelled one of the sessions has recorded zero vehicles speeding during a half hour session from 289 passing vehicles.
