Speedwatch Report

Parish Council 22nd July 2021

During June we ran 10 sessions totalling 6.5 hours, a further 3 sessions were cancelled due to rain, a total of 1446 vehicles passed during the sessions, 49 were recorded over the speed limit (3.99%), fastest was 54mph, one of the vehicles recorded did not have current road tax.

Two of the sessions recorded over 10% of passing vehicles speeding, one of those was the first session since lockdown which had 13.9% of passing vehicles speeding, drivers had obviously got used to us not being there.

During June, owing to operator health issues and personal commitments, only three volunteers were available to carry out sessions, the situation will probably be similar during July, there were 13 sessions planned during July, weather permitting, however five have been cancelled due to weather or an operator becoming unavailable.

Until the end of the school term we are concentrating on running the sessions at Glebe Orchard and Parsonage Croft, mainly at school start and finish times.
