Speedwatch Report

Parish Council 19th Aug 2021

July has been a quiet month for sessions because of the continued temporary absence of operators due to health issues and other commitments. Just 8 sessions were run during the month, totalling 4.5 hours, those sessions recorded 26 speeding vehicles from 1226 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 48mph. Five further sessions were cancelled due to the weather and unexpected operator unavailability.

For August we only have two operators available so have only been able to set six sessions for the month, we hope to soon have some of the other operators back on sessions soon.

In September we have the annual nationwide road safety initiative Project EDWARD (https://projectedward.org/) when all Police Forces and other road safety organisations conduct as many roadside checks as possible, it takes place this year September $13^{th} - 17^{th}$.

Speedwatch is always involved with the initiative, the Etchingham group currently has 8 sessions planned for the week and more should be added nearer the date.
