Project EDWARD – Every year in September a national campaign is run, involving all Police Forces, the Fire Service, Speedwatch Groups and many other road safety organisations, running as many high profile roadside sessions and special events as possible, to highlight road safety issues. We always try to carry out as many roadside sessions as possible during the week. **EDWARD** stands for **E**very **D**ay **W**ithout **A R**oad **D**eath.

- **A** = Vision to the west obscured for half of the session due to a heating oil delivery.
- **B** = One vehicle had been recorded previously.
- **C** = One vehicle failed DVLA check because of colour mismatch, but registration number and make were correct.
- **D** = One vehicle had been recorded on a previous session.
- **E** = One of the recorded vehicles was a green minibus, listed at DVLA as white, so colour change has not been notified to DVLA.
- \mathbf{F} = One vehicle was also reported for overtaking dangerously (55mph).
- **G** = One vehicle failed the DVLA check, reason unknown, possibly a keying error during input
- **H** = One vehicle had been recorded previously and had also been recorded by the Benenden CSW group

1AB = One vehicle not speeding, but reported for abusive gestures.

Records stay on the Operation Crackdown and Community Speedwatch records for 12months and are then deleted. The Community Speedwatch system displays the details (without registration) of any vehicles recorded by the same group more than once in the previous 12 months, those details are included at the bottom of this summary each month.
