Speedwatch Report

Parish Council 17th February 2022

During January the number of sessions run by the group have increased, we ran 27 sessions during the month, totalling 14 hours, those sessions recorded 80 speeding vehicles from 3490 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 43mph.

Seven of those sessions did not record any speeding vehicles, we were also able to run five sessions at the same time as Burwash and one further sessions had to be cancelled because of rain.

On the session on 17th January a vehicle was recorded by the Punnets Town group at 9.25am, we recorded the same vehicle at 9.36am it had also been recorded by Burwash in April and July last year, referred to NPT in July, and again for the January records.

There was vehicle on the repeat list this month, we had previously recorded that vehicle in October, one driver was reported for abusive behaviour.

A few points from the overview for all of the Sussex CSW groups. A total of 344 sessions were run during the month that reported 3,771 vehicles, 87 were shown to not have MOT and 10 were on a SORN so should not have been on the road.
