

# Speedwatch Report

*Parish Council 17<sup>th</sup> March 2022*

During February the number of sessions run by the group was about average, we ran 25 sessions during the month, totalling 12.5 hours, those sessions recorded 68 speeding vehicles from 3221 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 50mph.

Six of those sessions did not record any speeding vehicles, those were all at Glebe Orchard monitoring traffic passing the Parsonage Croft entrance from Burwash, all were at school drop off or pick up times, Which is encouraging.

We were also able to run five sessions at the same time as Burwash. Six further sessions had to be cancelled due to a combination of rain, Storm Eunice and illness.

There was one vehicle on the repeat list last month, we had recorded that vehicle twice within two weeks, one driver was reported for abusive behaviour.

A few points from the overview for all of the Sussex CSW groups. A total of 385 sessions were run during the month that reported 4,820 vehicles, 115 were shown to not have MOT and 13 were on a SORN so should not have been on the road.
