

Speedwatch Report

Parish Council 21st April 2022

During March the number of sessions run by the group was a bit above average, we ran 31 sessions during the month, totalling 16 hours, those sessions recorded 122 speeding vehicles from 4121 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 54mph, one vehicle was untaxed.

Nine of those sessions did not record any speeding vehicles, those were mostly at school drop off or pick up times, which is encouraging, BUT also six sessions recorded over 10% of the vehicles speeding, which is less encouraging.

We ran two sessions at the same times as Burwash sessions. Twelve further sessions had to be cancelled, five because of rain, seven because operators were unexpectedly not available.

There were three vehicles on the repeat list last month, another vehicle was recorded by Burwash that Etchingham had recorded on two previous sessions, three drivers were reported for abusive behaviour.

We have not yet received the overview of Sussex CSW groups for March.
