Speedwatch Report

Parish Council 20th May 2022

During April the number of sessions run by the group was a lot below average, due to a combination of holidays, health issues and personal commitments of operators.

We ran 13 sessions during the month, totalling 7 hours, those sessions recorded 39 speeding vehicles from 1673 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 45mph, one vehicle we recorded for the third time this year.

One session did not record any speeding vehicles, but one session recorded 10 speeding from 87 passing vehicles (11.49%).

Two further sessions had to be cancelled, one because of rain, one because an operator was unexpectedly not available.

One driver was reported for abusive behaviour.

A couple of points from the overview of Sussex CSW groups for April – across Sussex 80 of the reported vehicles did not have current MOT and 18 were ona SORN so should not have been driven on the road.
