## **Speedwatch Report**

## Parish Council 21st July 2022

During June the number of sessions run by the group was a lot lower than normal, due to a combination of holidays, health issues and personal commitments of operators.

We ran 12 sessions during the month, totalling 6 hours, those sessions recorded 40 speeding vehicles from 1563 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 44mph, two vehicles were recorded for the second time this year.

Three further sessions had to be cancelled because operators were unexpectedly not available.

Sessions have also been very low during July, due to holidays, health issues and personal commitments of operators, so far this month 12 sessions have been completed. We have two more planned, but our device has to go in for repair, we had hoped to get it back quickly but the workshop inform me that they have technicians that have tested positive for Covid, making them short staffed, so work is being delayed. We hope to be able to run more sessions in August.
