

Speedwatch Report

Parish Council 16th June 2022

During May the number of sessions run by the group was a lot below average, due to a combination of holidays, health issues and personal commitments of operators.

We ran 15 sessions during the month, totalling 7.5 hours, those sessions recorded 49 speeding vehicles from 1675 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 47mph, two vehicles were recorded for the second time this year.

One vehicle failed the DVLA check due to an accidental input of wrong colour.

One of the sessions was Police supported by the attendance of PCSO 41185.

Two sessions did not record any speeding vehicles, but one session recorded 11 speeding from 96 passing vehicles (11.46%).

Two further sessions had to be cancelled, one because of rain, one because an operator was unexpectedly not available.

Sessions will be very low during June, just seven sessions planned, due to holidays, health issues and personal commitments of operators, we hope to run more sessions in July and August.
