

Speedwatch Report

Parish Council 16th February 2023

During January the number of sessions run by the group was a bit below average, due mainly to operator availability.

We ran 15 sessions during the month of January, totalling 7.5 hours, those sessions recorded 33 speeding vehicles from 1510 passing vehicles, the fastest speed recorded was 43mph, 2 vehicles were recorded by Etchingham for the second time in the last 12 months, 1 for the third time.

A further four sessions were cancelled due to rain.

During February 25 sessions have been planned, but so far three sessions have been cancelled because an operator became unavailable.

A few bits from the county overview of sessions by all Sussex groups. Of the 316 registered groups 55 were active during January, those groups ran 275 broadside sessions and submitted 2,769 reports, with a 93.46% accuracy. Across the county there were 75 reports of abuse to Speedwatch groups.
